Mark's gospel is structured around the question, 'Who is Jesus?'. In the middle of the gospel, Jesus himself brings this question, asking his disciples first 'Who do

people say I am?' and then more pointedly, 'Who do you say I am?' This term we will be looking at a chapter of Mark each week and asking the question afresh, 'Who is this man and what difference does our answer make?'

7th Dec The Reconnect Women's Group will host a **Christmas Craft and Reflection** event


14th Dec is our main **Carol Service** where we'll have a mix of carols old and new, along with a clear presentation of the good news of Christmas
